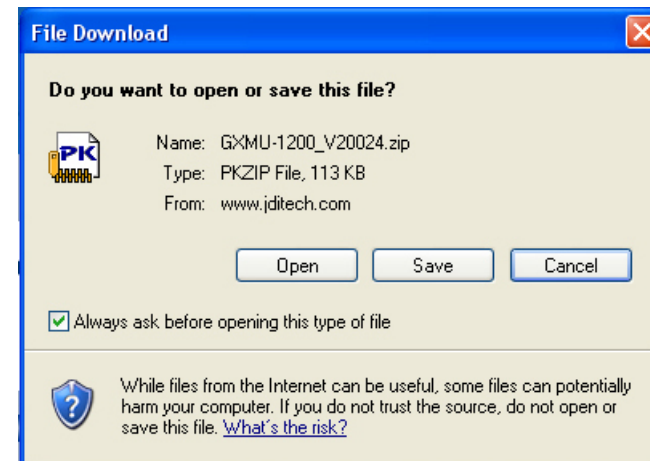

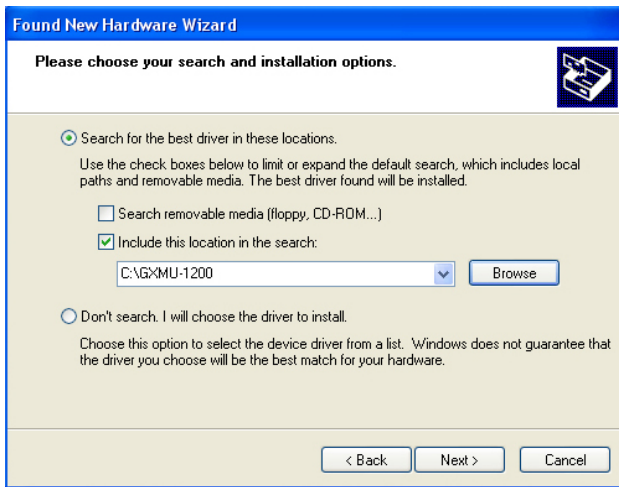

21. Click **Next >**

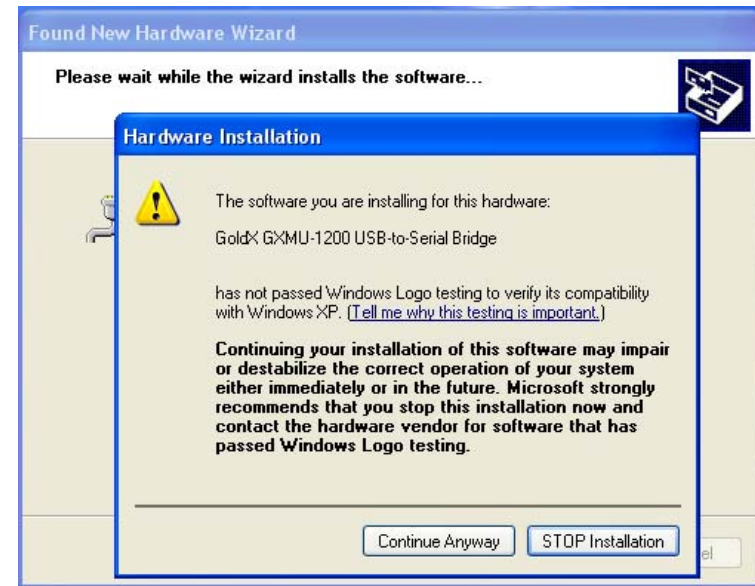


22. Chose **Search for the best driver in these locations**
